Dear **ALUMNI, PARENTS, and FRIENDS** of Greensboro College:



For 180 years, we at Greensboro College have loved helping our students define their own paths to a fulfilling future. And we're good at it: Earlier this fall, we were recognized as a Top 20 college in the Southern region in U.S. News & World Report's 2018 Best Colleges.

A few weeks ago, we announced that we also would be defining the college's own path for the future of liberal-arts education.

Defining the Path is Greensboro College's response to what students and parents have told us they want most: a great education, a degree they can afford to finish, and direction toward a successful career and a meaningful life.

Defining the Path focuses on five C's: Curriculum, Community, Career, Campus, and Cost.

Our faculty members are continually examining and evolving our curriculum, combining the traditional benefits of a liberal-arts education – a strong foundation in critical thinking, analysis, problem-solving and communication – with changes to meet the needs of a rapidly changing world.

We are expanding our connections to the community and careers at the local, state, national and international levels, from study-away opportunities to experiential and service-learning, utilizing resources ranging from a vibrant downtown district just steps from campus to the talented people serving on the advisory boards of the college's five academic schools.

We are improving our campus, as you'll read in this issue, with the establishment of the First Citizens Bank Global Communications Center, a new athletic-training center and air conditioning in Hanes Gymnasium, and a state-of-the-art fiber-optic network on campus. Later this year we'll also be opening a new student-activities center with coffee shop and micro-store in the same location where a similar facility, remembered by many alumni as "The Stu," was for many years. No one project is a blockbuster, but the combination is the most work that has gone on here on campus at one time in 20 years.

And, critically, we are working on making sure that a Greensboro College education remains accessible and affordable to more families by realigning our projected tuition and fees for Fall 2019 and restructuring financial aid to best align available resources with individual students' needs.

Small, private, liberal-arts colleges face many challenges today. So do families. But Greensboro College has been providing preparation and value to students for 180 years, and we intend to continue that work and service for many years to come. We hope to see you on campus along the way.

GREENSBORO COLLEGE TAKES ACTION TO EMPOWER A NEW GENERATION OF STUDENTS

Abby Bigger '19 speaks with a sense of nostalgia about her time at Greensboro College, despite the fact that she is still a semester away from graduation. "Greensboro College will always be a part of me," she says. Her earnest assessment of her time here is just one of the things that makes her unique; she's present, in the moment, poised, and mature in a way that defies how young people are generally described these days.

What's most interesting, though, is that Abby's words are not unique. Many of her classmates, as well as recent graduates, echo those same sentiments. And perhaps that's the real legacy of this 180-year-old liberal-arts college, a place where young people find their callings, develop new talents and forge lifelong friends. Once you breathe in the oak-filled air, it never leaves you.

Abby and her classmates speak naturally of the paths they are on, passing literally and figuratively under the shadows of Greensboro College's historic buildings.

The administration, too, is speaking of paths these days. After years of assessing all aspects of the Greensboro College experience and exploring ways to make itself more accessible, relevant and responsive to the needs of this and future generations, leaders are embarking on an ambitious path, with a clear vision of the future.

Greensboro College President Lawrence D. Czarda, Ph.D., is leading this journey. "Every student deserves access to the type of education we offer: personal and experiential, with one-on-one attention and real career support," he says. "We're taking action to make Greensboro College more accessible to students and families, and to enhance every aspect of our educational experience."

The actions include several visionary initiatives, including a realignment of the college's tuition, fees and

institutional financial-aid programs, as well as continual evolution of the academic curriculum, enhancement of career support services, and improvements to the historic campus.

Dr. Czarda clearly has his eye on the horizon. “We’ve done the research,” he says. “We understand the priorities of today’s higher-education students: access, affordability, degree completion and career readiness. Everything we’re doing allows us to deliver on those priorities.”

The tuition realignment, which will take effect in the fall semester of the 2019-20 academic year, will reduce projected tuition and fees from \$30,440 to \$18,500 – and that’s before financial aid is calculated.

In addition to affordability, Dr. Czarda believes the realignment offers greater transparency for students and families.

“By realigning our tuition and institutional financial-aid models this way, students and families have a better idea of what college

actually costs,” he says. “It just makes good sense.”

Even as tuition is decreasing, Greensboro College is ramping up investment in the curriculum, campus, and career services.

The college’s award-winning faculty is examining and evolving the liberal-arts curriculum, developing programs to address society’s most relevant needs, including majors in Health Sciences, Exercise and Sport Studies, Urban Ecology, and Human Development and Family Science, as well as concentrations such as Digital Music Production and Human Factors Psychology. These subjects will stand side-by-side with Greensboro College’s core of tradition liberal-arts majors such as English, Education, and Business Administration.

“We’re building on the foundation of our liberal-arts education – critical thinking, analysis, and communication – with programs that are attuned to our evolving society,” said Dr. Paul Leslie, Chief Academic Officer.

To augment the learning that happens on campus, Greensboro College is also forging partnerships across the local, national and global community, including for-profit, nonprofit and government entities, in an effort to expand experiential learning and service opportunities for students.

“Studying abroad opened my mind to the world,” says Bügger. “The experience led me to discover a whole new passion – working with people with disabilities – that I now hope to pursue as a career path.”

While expanding students’ access to the world is a top priority, Greensboro College is also enhancing the experience here at home, with several enhancements to the 180-year-old campus. A state-of-the-art

technology infrastructure was recently completed, and a new Athletic Training Center, Student Center, and First Citizens Bank Global Communication Center will open this year.

And a recently announced five-year, \$1.93 million grant from the Department of Education will allow the college to add staff and programs aimed at ensuring that students complete their degrees.

“I know I speak for our whole college community when I say we couldn’t be more excited about all the new things coming to our historic campus,” said Dr. Czarda.

Abby Bügger and her classmates couldn’t agree more. While fully immersed in their academic experience today, they can already envision the pride of calling of themselves Greensboro College alumni ... for the rest of their lives.

“INSTILLING THE CULTURE OF GIVING BACK TO SOCIETY”

Greensboro College trustee Lynn Lane '73 and her husband, Pat, have been among the college's staunchest financial supporters, from endowing a scholarship and supporting the Women in Philanthropy and Leadership program to including the college in their estate plans. Director of Communications Lex Alexander talked with the Lanes about the importance of philanthropy, in society and in the lives of individual students like theatre-education major Caroline Meisner '19, the current Lane Scholar. The conversation has been edited for length and clarity.

Q: *What led you to give back to GC in the first place, and why has it remained important to you?*

A: Greensboro College developed me into the person I am today. It helped me become successful in life (and) helped me feel comfortable with taking leadership roles. ...

We strongly believe that those who are capable of giving back to society in some ways they value should do so. We also believe (in) educating and training members of society via a quality college experience for not only productive careers but also ... for citizens who can become better members of society, perhaps its leaders. That leads us to our passion for supporting higher education.

We have had some really good experiences with some students, professors and administrators at both GC and East Carolina University (Pat Lane's alma mater) that reinforce our passion for providing not only financial but also volunteer leadership and advocacy support. ... We provide support to enable them to provide those opportunities to others for not only education per se but in instilling the culture of giving back to society.

Q: *What specific interests led you to have given as you have?*

A: As to scholarship, we (want) to attract students to GC who can potentially become the leaders and/or difference makers ... that we believe are essential to the future of our state, nation, and the world. ... Our targeted scholarship interest is about careful identification, selection and attraction of students with the potential to make a huge difference post-graduation. We try

to develop personal relationships with those students ... so we can nurture them as mentors, learn from them as believers in them, and instill a culture of giving so that they will give back when they are able.

With regard to Women in Philanthropy and Leadership ... we see women as collectively having the skill set to be outstanding leaders in any part of society, and that includes active participation in philanthropy. We hope that this program will empower more GC and other women to become more active in directing the giving of their families to causes they value ... and assuming leadership roles, whether it be participating (on) or chairing committees, assuming senior staff or teaching roles, or becoming strong advocates.

As to planned giving, we believe that those who had the passion to provide financial support to GC in life should include support for the same programs at GC in their estate plans because that ensures that the activities they valued in life will be perpetuated.

Q: *What advice would you have for other alumni who are pondering what aspects of GC to support with their gifts?*

A: First, keep in touch with GC if you had a great experience there. ... Second, reflect on what you value about your GC experience. What can you do to ensure that future students with like interests and values receive that same experience? ... Simply put, focus on what you can do to perpetuate the experience that you had or improve upon it. ... If you really believe in something, you are likely to give it your time and your money and to receive reinforcement for your support as you see your passions fulfilled.

Q: *What would you say to young alumni or others who think, "I don't have a lot of money. I can't donate a building or endow a scholarship or program, so why should I give at all?"*

A: The main thing is to begin to work toward goals that you value. ... Understand the value of being part of something that you believe in. A very small part might grow over time as none of us knows what life has in store. Your initial \$50 can't make a huge difference by itself but it will be combined with the gifts of others to do something that you alone cannot do right now.

Just get into the habit of doing what you can each year financially. And don't forget that you likely have some time you could donate as a volunteer, especially if you live near Greensboro. ... Simply ask what you could do. The relationships that may evolve may surprise you -- and impact GC more than you may ever have thought.

HONORED HER CURTIS FAMILY LEGACY WITH A HALF-MILLION-DOLLAR ESTATE GIFT

Charlotte Anderson Straney loved her family, higher education, music, history, and her friends – not in any particular order.

Although she was young in heart and mind when she died on March 25, 2018, at 72 years of age, she had battled poor health for years. Despite those confines, she attended scholarship donor luncheons at Greensboro College and most concerts at the Eastern Music Festival, and was a constant force in the lives of her many friends.

It was no surprise to anyone who knew her that she left her sizable estate to charitable causes to help others. What did render a roomful of her Curtis family speechless was the announcement by her brother Chip this past spring that she had bequeathed more than \$500,000 to the Greensboro College scholarship fund started by her grandfather, W.M. Curtis.

Walter Makepeace Curtis (1867-1955) made his impact on Greensboro College as secretary-treasurer and business manager from 1905 to 1939. He created The Lucy and Letitia Evans Curtis Scholarship, the beneficiary of his granddaughter Charlotte's major gift, 100 years ago in 1918.

A quick overview of Curtis family history is needed to understand the deep connection Charlotte felt to Greensboro College and this scholarship.

The Makepeace-Curtis family's involvement dates back to the college's earliest days, when W.M.'s mother, Lucy Ellen Makepeace, attended Greensboro Female College in 1855-56. W.M.'s first wife, Kate Kendell Wright (who died in 1902), attended GFC in the late 1880s, and their daughter Lucy Kendell Curtis was in the Class of 1918. W.M.'s second wife, Letitia Evans Curtis (whom he married in 1908), graduated in the Class of 1903. W.M.'s two sisters, two Makepeace cousins, and four of his other daughters attended in the late 1920s and 1930s. Charlotte's mother, Grace, attended GC, then went on to graduate from Duke.

Walter Makepeace Curtis was born and raised in Franklinville, N.C., where his father owned a cotton mill. At age 13, he felt called to the Methodist ministry and graduated from UNC in 1889. A circuit-riding preacher in the Piedmont area of North Carolina, he was known for his fundraising success in building many new churches. Following the 1904 fire that destroyed Greensboro Female College, the trustees persuaded him to join the administration as secretary-treasurer, primarily to raise \$100,000 in endowment funds to rebuild the college.

Still a widower in 1907, W.M. Curtis and his mother bought the property at 108 Odell Place and built a house into which he moved his mother and two small daughters. After he married Letitia Evans (to whom he was introduced by college President Lucy Robertson), they had four daughters and two sons. That house – the Curtis House – belongs to GC and is currently home to athletic coaches.

During his tenure at GC, Curtis raised \$30,000 to complete Main Building following the 1904 fire, \$107,000 in endowment funds, and funding for a dormitory, Fitzgerald Hall. Through astute investing, Curtis held onto the college's

endowment throughout World War I and the Great Depression. He took extreme measures to keep the college open and pay its employees, driving to Concord, N.C., to cash payroll checks at the closest open bank. He taught religion courses and recruited students. He also wrote some of the most complete financial histories that we have of GC, including one that he wrote upon his retirement in 1939 to which we still frequently refer.

Curtis created one of our oldest endowment funds in 1918, the same year his mother and daughter, both GC alumnae, died -- his 79-year-old mother we assume of illness brought on by old age, and his daughter by the flu epidemic that year.

He wrote: "My mother left me in her Will, a little more than two thousand dollars. I gave around one-half of the amount to Greensboro College to establish a scholarship in memory of my mother and daughter, both of them having the name Lucy Curtis."

That scholarship, the Lucy Curtis Scholarship, was established and awarded for 60 years before the second fund -- The Letitia Evans Curtis Class of 1903 Scholarship -- was created by her children and grandchildren upon her death in 1979. At some point, these two endowments were combined, and as of June 30, 2017, the endowment fund was valued at \$52,053. Charlotte and her brother Chip Anderson have long been the contacts on what is now named the Lucy and Letitia Evans Curtis Scholarship because their mother, Grace, was a lead donor in its establishment.

Letitia Evans Curtis '03 was in her own right quite important to the college, including her service as President of the Alumni Association in 1929-1930. Incidentally, each year, past alumni board presidents from the late 1880s until now are remembered with

a listing in the Alumni Reunion Weekend booklet. Dozens of Curtis Scholars have kept Lucy and Letitia's memories alive, one of the appeals of the endowment fund to Charlotte (in addition to helping young people receive an education and pride in W.M. Curtis' legacy to GC).

Charlotte had the family scholarship listed as a beneficiary in her estate plan. It was on her "bucket list" to have the family home on Odell Place acknowledged as the Curtis House. To make this happen for Charlotte, her brother Chip documented his estate plans for the college in the GC20/20 Capital Campaign, which the college acknowledged with a plaque on the Curtis House. To celebrate, Charlotte planned a family lunch on April 20, 2018, in Lea Center in Main Building for Curtis family members from across the country.

This spring, a few weeks before 36 Curtis family members gathered for a family photo on the front porch (with the plaque mounted on the front of the house in the background), Charlotte peacefully passed away after seeing a photo of the plaque mounted on the house and giving college staff a few final instructions for the luncheon she had planned. Charlotte was pleased and proud for her Curtis family to celebrate their strong connections to Greensboro College, still very much their family home.

During the luncheon, Chip Anderson remembered his sister Charlotte and made the surprise announcement about her estate gift to the Lucy and Letitia Evans Curtis Scholarship Fund. He also presented a beautiful framed collage, designed and commissioned by Charlotte and now on display in the college's Brock Historical Museum, depicting W.M. Curtis's GC career and the "long, green line" of Makepeace and Curtis family members.

NEW GLOBAL COMMUNICATION CENTER WILL ENHANCE STUDENTS’ 21ST-CENTURY MEDIA FLUENCY

Later this academic year, the First Citizens Bank Global Communication Center will open to enhance students’ fluency in 21st-century communication skills and provide support in writing, speaking, and composing with digital media.

campus. While professional writing consultations will continue to be offered in two ways — one-on-one meetings and online sessions — the new floor plan will provide a more spacious and comfortable setting for consultations, which are free to students as well as others in the college community.

Named for the college’s banking partner, whose gift began the initiative, the project, which will be completed with funds from a recently announced four-year, \$1.93 million U.S. Department of Education Title III grant for degree-completion initiatives, will be located on the garden level of the James Addison Jones Library.

Additional resources for English language learners will help both students and instructors achieve their communication goals. The center eventually will include a recording studio for students to produce podcasts and high-quality audio; a space for video-recording student oral presentations so that students can receive feedback for improvement from an expert through the consultation system; and computer stations that allow students to produce multimedia-rich projects for courses across the curriculum using state-of- the-art software.

The space will be renovated to maximize accessibility for all individuals, including a redesigned main entrance from the patio outside the library. Plans for the center emphasize collaborative seating, adjustable tables and chairs, and a reconfigurable design to allow different types of learning scenarios.

During the current semester, many of these services already are being offered, but elsewhere on campus while the space is prepared.

The First Citizens Bank Global Communication Center significantly upgrades the writing support offered on

college’s Degree Completion Task Force addressing the issues of progression, retention and graduation rates in undergraduate students,” said the college’s president, Lawrence D. Czarda, Ph.D.

center’s operations,” said Dr. Kathleen Keating, chair of the Department of English, Communication & Media Studies, which will help staff the center.

“First Citizens Bank is pleased to join with Greensboro College in establishing this cutting-edge center that will allow students to develop and refine their writing and communication skills, which are so important for success in today’s world,” the bank said in a statement. “Greensboro College has been educating young people in our region for 180 years, and we’re proud to be a partner in their efforts as part of our Forever First commitment to the communities we serve.”

“We are very fortunate that our banking partner, First Citizens Bank, has a keen interest in the academic success of all our students. ... The First Citizens Bank Global Communication Center will be an important resource for all students, most of whom will benefit from advancing their academic and professional communication skills.”

Students will play a key role in “every aspect of the



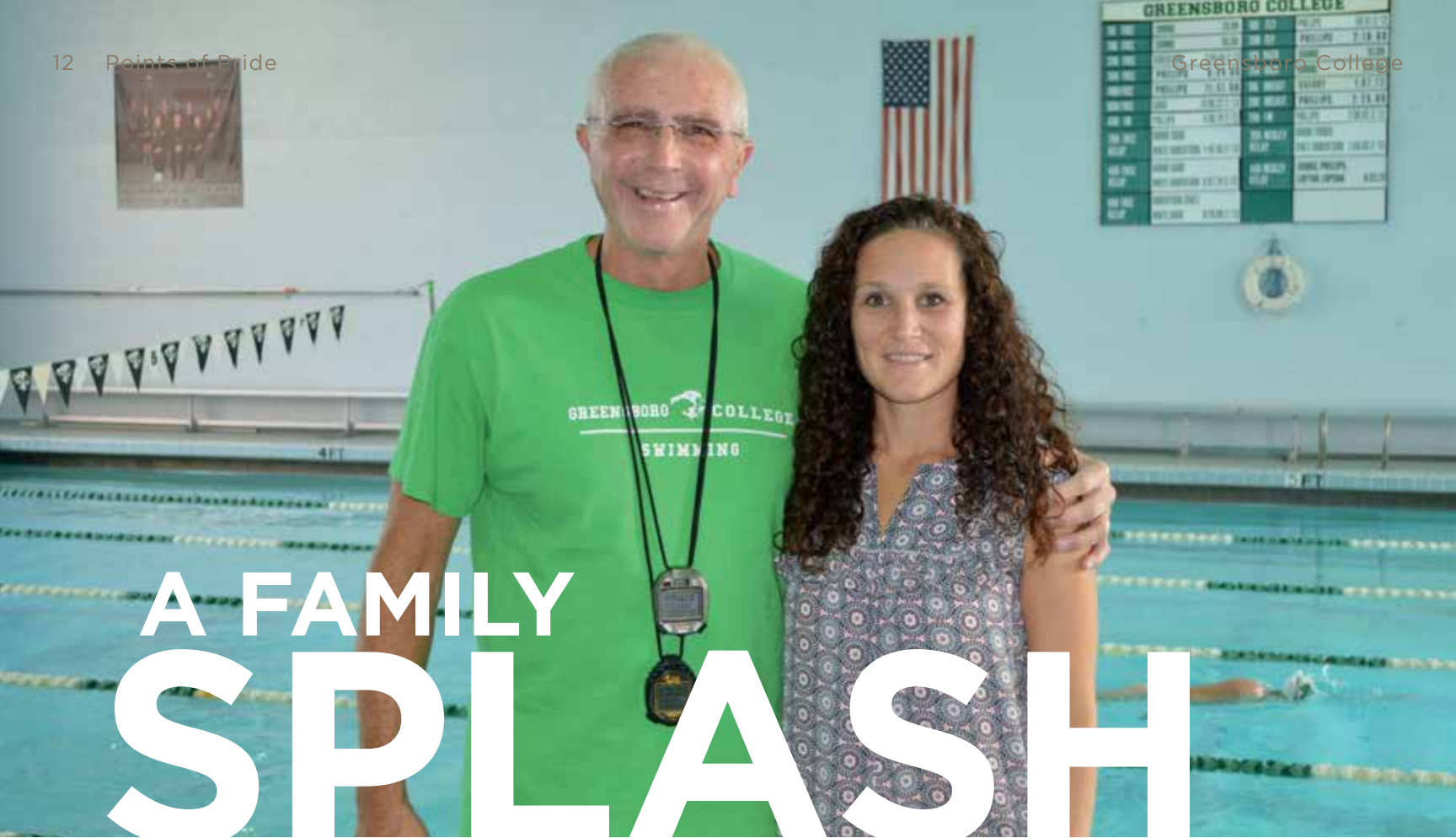
INVESTING in the FUTURE

You can’t point to one big construction project on the Greensboro College campus. But as President Lawrence D. Czarda, Ph.D., has pointed out, lot of smaller projects in the past year and a half have added up to the most active period of renovation on campus in 20 years.

- Consider:
- Upgrading the campus’s fiber-optic computer network to state of the art, originally a five-year project under the college’s current GC2020 strategic plan, was accelerated in mid-2017 and is now complete.
 - Air conditioning has been replaced in Cowan Humanities Building, and thanks to a generous gift from a donor, it is being installed in Hanes Gymnasium.
 - A new athletic training center is being installed in the north end of Hanes. When it is complete, athletic training will move from the Campbell Athletic Center to Hanes.
 - The Campbell Athletic Center will be renovated later this year into a new student activities center, complete with coffee shop and micro-store, similar to “The Stu” that decades of alumni remember in that spot.
 - The First Citizens Bank Global Communication Center (described in more detail elsewhere in this issue) is being established on the garden level of J.A. Jones Library and will open later this academic year.
 - New directional signage has been installed around campus, and we have a new sign at the main entrance to campus as well as an electronic marquee in front of the Admissions Welcome Center.
 - Sidewalk and stairway repairs begun this past spring have been completed on back campus, and masonry has been repaired on front campus.

When Greensboro College needed a new head men’s and women’s swimming coach this past summer, it certainly wasn’t the job of a psychology professor to go find one.

But Kristin Sheridan ’05 was delighted to do it, because she didn’t have to go far.

Her in-laws, Jim and Meika Sheridan, had moved to North Carolina from Indiana to be close to their grandkids. Jim had had a decades-long record of success in swim coaching, including building Division I Clemson’s women’s team into a Top 20 program.

But Jim Sheridan didn’t care that Greensboro College’s athletic program is Division III and doesn’t offer scholarships. After the move to North Carolina, but before he learned about the job opening, “I spent a week at the GAC (Greensboro Aquatic Center) talking to coaches,” Jim Sheridan said. “I just wanted to be involved.”

Kristin Sheridan put her father in touch with athletics director Bryan Galuski.

“He said, ‘Why would you come here?’” Jim Sheridan says. “But GC, to me, is one of the best-kept secrets in America. It’s a small college, but it’s in a big town – you’ve got athletics, you’ve got academics, you’ve got the arts.”

One thing he says he doesn’t miss is the pressure that goes with running a Division I program. Being at GC, he says, lets him bring student athletes in “and help them succeed as students as well as athletes.”

He is able to do that, he says, because of the college’s generally hands-off management ethos.

“GC does a great job with the faculty and staff of promoting autonomy,” Kristin Sheridan says. “They just trust the faculty and staff.”

Jim Sheridan says his coaching philosophy fits well with that environment.

“I just lay out the workouts, and (the swimmers) follow them,” he says. “The kids say it’s nice to be able to come in to practice 30 seconds late, because they’d had to stop and talk to a professor, and not get yelled at. That’s important. I can’t tell you how many (individual) national champions I’ve coached, but I know I have over 460 doctors out there as a coach, and over 300 lawyers.”

One other thing that struck Jim Sheridan when his son John Sheridan ’05, now Kristin’s husband, was an undergraduate was the relationships his son enjoyed with faculty and administrators – relationships that benefited him even after graduation.

“He got a lot of help from Main Building,” Jim Sheridan says, “and I use that to recruit. We’ve already had 10 unofficial visits (from prospective student athletes) this year.”

GREENSBORO COLLEGE ALUMNI HONOR THREE OF THEIR OWN

Three Greensboro College alumni received awards from the college’s Alumni Association during the college’s Alumni Awards and Student Investiture Program April 6.



Nicholas DeFelice ’07 received the Young Alumni Award in recognition of his service and performance as a deputy in the Calvert County (Md.) Sheriff’s Office.

He became the youngest member of that office to be promoted to detective, an honor he earned in just his second year of service. In 2009 and 2013 he was named Detective of the Year by the Calvert County Sheriff’s Office. In 2010 the State Attorney’s Office named him Detective of the Year. In 2009 he was named Officer of the Year by the Optimist Club of Calvert County, and in 2014 he received the Maryland Sheriff’s Association Deputy of the Year Award for Contributions to Professionalism. In 2017, Nicholas was elected by his colleagues as president of the Fraternal Order of Police for the Calvert County Sheriff’s Office.

He is an adjunct professor at the College of Southern Maryland and is a guest instructor at the Southern Maryland Criminal Justice Academy. When he has free time, he volunteers as an assistant coach for the Northern High School varsity lacrosse team and travels to area high schools to teach practical skills in law enforcement.

The Young Alumni Award, re-established in 2012, recognizes alumni younger than 35 years of age who have contributed outstanding service and achievement as humanitarians and/or professionals in their chosen endeavor. Service, commitment, integrity and success are the key factors in making these awards.



Trustee Karen Anzola ’86 received the Distinguished Alumni Award. She was honored not only for her service on the Alumni Board, including as president, but also for her volunteer

leadership positions at her local United Methodist church and at other churches.

She also was cited for her efforts to raise awareness of and funds for the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, and for her more than 30 years of work in the field of developmental disabilities and early-childhood education, including two years as co-director of the National Center for Family/ Professional Partnerships.

The Distinguished Alumni Award, established in 1966, recognizes those who have continually served the college in community and religious affairs and have demonstrated outstanding service or accomplishment in their personal or professional lives.



Kevin Eagan ’04 received the Alumni Excellence Award. He was cited for his leadership as assistant professor in residence

and director of the Cooperative Institute Research Program, the nation’s largest and longest-running empirical study of higher education. He also is interim managing director of the Higher Education Research Institute at the University of California at Los Angeles and a Huffington Post contributor.

The Alumni Excellence Award, established in 1990, recognizes alumni who have contributed outstanding service and achievement as humanitarians and/or professionals in their chosen endeavors. Service, commitment, integrity and success are the key factors in making these awards.

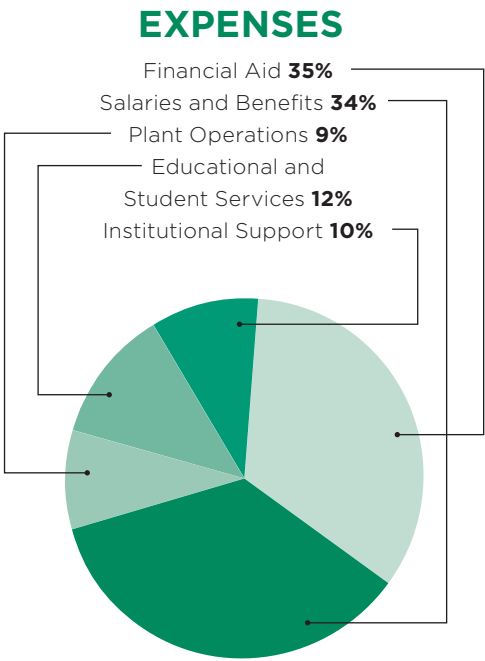
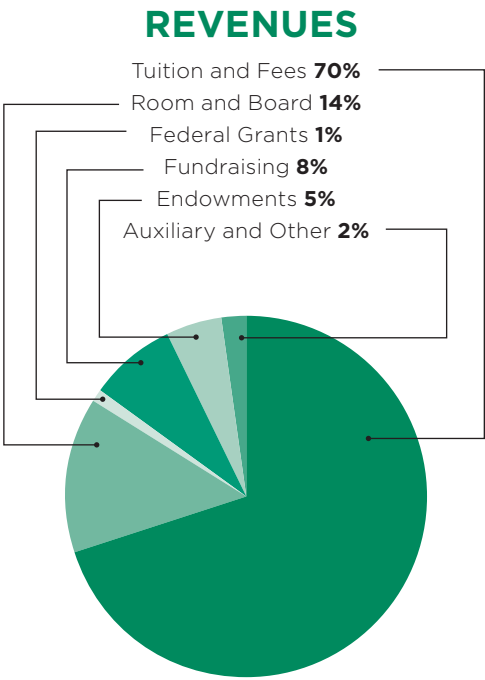

CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER REPORT FOR 2017-2018

OUR FINANCIAL PICTURE

For the fifth consecutive year, Greensboro College's finances received a clean audit report with no management findings from our auditors, Dixon

Hughes Goodman. By carefully managing expenses, we ended fiscal year 2018 in the black, even while giving faculty and staff a salary increase. Our composite score with the U.S. Department of Education was strong, thereby ensuring federal financial assistance for our students who qualify. We added more than \$500,000 to our permanent assets through charitable gifts of endowment funds and \$890,000 in property.

OUR REVENUES

Greensboro College relies heavily on tuition, fees, room and board (84% of budget), so student enrollment is crucial to our financial well-being. Funds raised from donors – both restricted to specific programs and unrestricted – provide 8% of our operating budget. Another 5% of our revenues comes from investment earnings from our permanent endowment funds, which were given by donors over the years. We receive no revenue from the state; federal grants comprised 1% of our budget last year. Facilities rentals and other auxiliary programs brought in about 2% of revenues.

OUR EXPENSES

Financial aid in the form of scholarships is our largest expenditure (35%), followed by faculty and staff salaries and benefits (34%). Institutional support and plant operations comprise 20% of our expenses, with 12% spent on educational and student services.

OUR CAMPUS

Campus presentation, renewal and enhancement continue to be important to GC. During fiscal year 2018, we completed and began several large projects including: new underground fiber-optic cabling, servers and switches for enhanced network connectivity and performance, new campus signage, concrete sidewalk and step replacement, new air-conditioning system for the Cowan Humanities Building, and Hanes Gym air conditioning and renovations for a new Athletic Training Center. Through a new food-service partnership with Chartwells Higher Ed, we are in the process of updating Fowler Dining Hall. Renovations to The Student Center, including a new Starbucks coffee shop, should be complete in 2018-19.

OUR ENDOWMENT

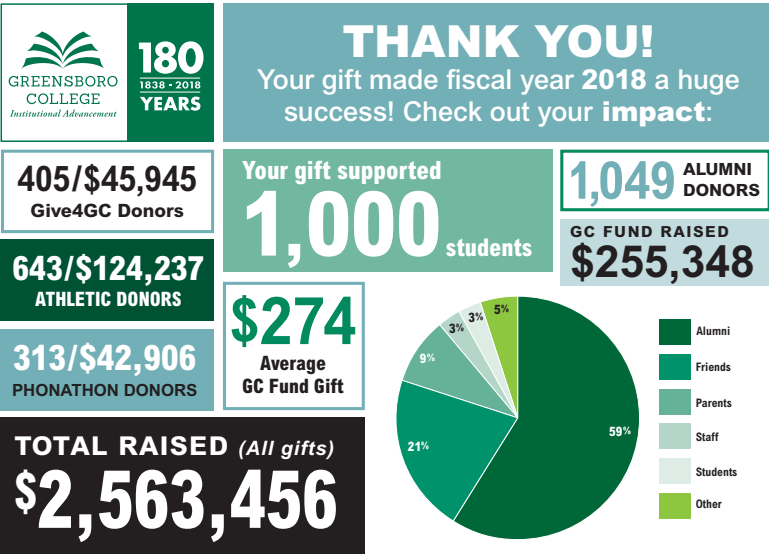
A Board of Trustees Investment Committee sets and monitors performance benchmarks of our endowment funds, managed and invested now by First Citizens Wealth Management. Our endowment funds, totaling \$23.9 million as of June 30, are invested in a well-diversified asset mix, which includes equity and debt securities, intended to result in a consistent, inflation-protected rate of return that has sufficient liquidity to make an annual distribution of 4.5% while growing the funds over time. In all cases, we carefully follow the donors' intended purposes of their funds.

OUR FUTURE

I appreciate the rich history of this college and consider it a privilege to steward the resources of this 180-year-old institution. I offer my own sincere thank-you to those who supported GC in 2017-2018.

GREENSBORO COLLEGE had another extraordinary year of giving in 2017-2018. Most notably, we announced that we surpassed our initial goal of \$15 million in the GC20/20: Uniquely Focused capital campaign – two years early! – with a total on June 30 of \$16,337,757. While we celebrate this important milestone and the generous support of our donors, this campaign will continue through the scheduled campaign period of June 2020 as we still have important parts of our strategic plan that need funding.

One goal of the campaign is to increase our percentage of alumni donors. This year, 1,049 alumni donors supported our alma mater, increasing our alumni support from 15% to 16%. We're closing in on our goal: to beat the national average of 19%.

A true highlight of the year was the extraordinary gift of the 501 Guilford Ave. property by The Michael W. Haley Foundation in October 2017. That property, which GC has leased for its theatre scene shop for the past

nine years, is planned to become an outdoor theatre named for former college president Craven Williams and his wife, Judith. We hope to raise an additional \$2 million to complete this project on the Downtown Greenway.

Between July 1, 2017, and June 30, 2018, donors made outright charitable gifts to Greensboro College of \$2,563,457. Each year, we ask alumni, families and friends to make GC a priority in their charitable giving, and we thank you for the tremendous impact you have had on GC students: in their classrooms, on their athletic teams, in stage performances, residence halls, and all aspects of student life. The giving impact report above highlights some of the fun giving data from the year.

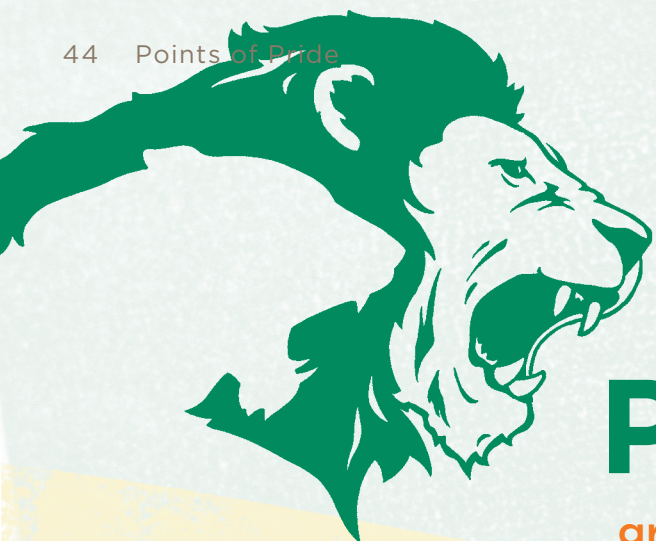

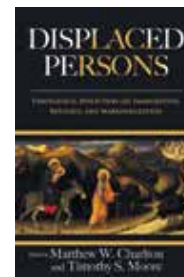

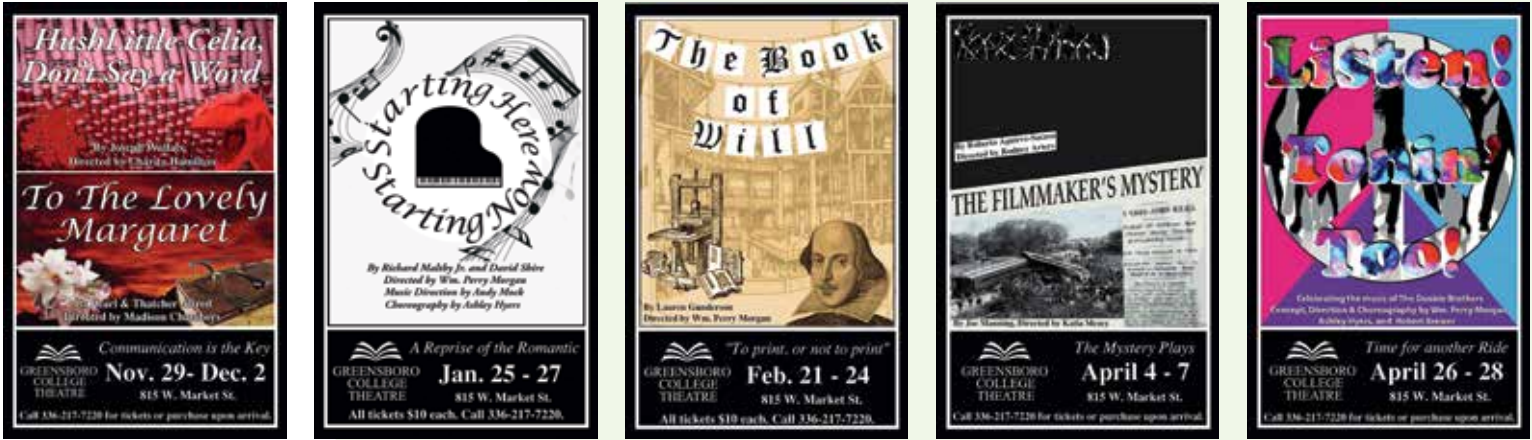
