The PEAK at a Glance

The Center for Academic Support at Greensboro College, also known as the PEAK (Personal Enrichment and Knowledge), provides academic support for students in a variety of ways. The PEAK is located on the third floor of Main Building, and students are encouraged to visit and make themselves at home. The PEAK staff provides support to students who need help in a particular subject, want to learn better study habits, or are on academic probation.



Peer Tutors

Peer tutors are available each semester in most first-year courses and some upper-level courses. Tutorial services are free for all students. Subjects and contact information for each tutor are posted on the bulletin board in the PEAK. You may schedule appointments beginning the second week of classes.

Academic Advising

All new students are assigned a first-year advisor upon enrollment. First-year advisors help ease the transition from high school to college. Students are reassigned to a faculty advisor in their major discipline in their second semester.

Academic Success

Students who are admitted into the Academic Success Program are required to meet with the Program Director regularly, earn stipulated grade-point averages, and fulfill other contractual requirements. The program is designed to maximize these students' chances for academic success.
