



CURRICULUM OUTLINE

Traditional undergraduate students at Greensboro College may earn any of four degrees:

- Bachelor of Arts (B.A.)
- Bachelor of Fine Arts (B.F.A.)
- Bachelor of Science (B.S.)
- Bachelor of Music Education (B.M.E.)

The curriculum for each of these degrees consists of five parts:

I. General Education (40 hours)

II. Major Requirements (32-56 hours for most majors)

Students must satisfy all major requirements specified in the Academic Catalog.

III. Greensboro College Seminar (2 hours)

IV. Define Your Path (1 hour)

V. Electives

Electives are any courses that do not fit into the General Education, Major, Greensboro College Seminar, or Define Your Path categories.

Most students will need some elective hours to reach the minimum number of 124 hours for graduation.
