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Final exams for all undergraduate and graduate online classes, including those in the Online BBA Program, Online Criminal Justice Program, Online Human Development and Family Science, and Online Psychology Programs:

Instructors of classes will schedule final exams according to each class's calendar and syllabus.

Important notes about final exams:

Students are required to take their final exams according to this schedule. Any request from a student to change the day/time of a final exam must be made via completion of a Petition for Exception to Academic Policy form no later than two weeks prior to the first day of exams for the session. The instructor(s) of the class must approve of the request before students submit their Petition to the Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost for approval. Instructors are not required to approve any requests to change the day/time of final exams.

Instructors who wish to change the day/time of a final exam may do so only if every student in the class has been given appropriate notice about the intended change and has agreed to the change. (See policy listed in the Faculty Handbook.) Additionally, if the time allowed for a final exam will be less than three hours, the instructor will notify the students in advance of the exam.

Students who are approved by the Office of Academic Accessibility for academic accommodations must adhere to all guidelines and deadlines for scheduling and completing their exams as instructed by the Director of the Office of Academic Accessibility.

All final grades must be submitted through Empower by the instructor(s) of classes. **Final grades for Spring 2026 classes for graduating students must be entered online no later than noon on Monday, May 4, 2026. Final grades for Spring 2026 classes for all other students must be entered online no later than noon on Tuesday, May 5, 2026.**
