

International Student Enrollment Guide Post F-1 Stamp



Steps to Complete Before Your First Semester at Greensboro College

1. Pay your \$250.00 deposit for the semester

Students must pay a \$250 deposit using: <https://pay.greensboro.edu/checkout/items/2> or through paymytuition.com

The deposit is deducted from overall tuition. Enrollment steps cannot continue until the deposit is paid.

2. Sign your Financial Responsibility Agreement (FRA)

After paying the deposit, students must sign the FRA. The FRA confirms the student understands their financial obligations. It must be signed before other steps can be completed.

3. Check your GC email and set up Moodle account

Students must check GC email daily. A New Student Checklist Packet will be emailed to the GC email account, this will contain instruction about logging into Moodle.

Moodle is used to:

- Enroll in the New Student Orientation course
- Submit the course registration request form
- Sign the housing contract
- Upload the student ID/Pride card photo

4. Research and book your flight to the US

You need to make sure that you arrive during the international arrival dates, which will be communicated once you pay your \$250.00 deposit. Please send a copy of your travel itinerary to internationalprograms@greensboro.edu

You can arrive in the US 30 days prior to the I-20 start date. See the date listed under “Earliest Admission Date” on your I-20. If you plan to arrive before the international arrivals date, then you will need to arrange for airport pick-up and off campus housing until the international arrivals day.

5. Purchase your student health insurance

6. Paying your semester tuition

Students should continue checking email. The Student Accounts Office will email when the semester bill is ready. The email will include payment plan options and ways to pay the bill.

7. View the International Pre-Orientation video

Students should watch the video for a virtual campus visit and important arrival preparation information.

8. Attend the International Orientation upon arrival at GC for your first semester

Orientation is required for the first semester. It takes priority over other events, including athletic practices.

The orientation date will be communicated after the student obtains a visa. Flights should be scheduled to arrive in time for orientation.

If orientation is missed due to delays or other issues, the student must schedule a one-on-one session. The information is required by U.S. federal law.
